Jan. 15, 2024 (Mon) – May 17, 2024 (Fri)

Eligibility

- Students currently enrolled in an accredited college/university
- Academically motivated high school students or high school graduates (age 17+ in Year 11, 12)

Required Documents

- Copy of Academic Transcript
- Copy of Passport
- Proof of Health Insurance (only for students enrolled in in-person courses)
- Consent Letter signed by a legal guardian (only for pre-college students)

Application Procedures

- Complete the online application form at summer.korea.ac.kr
(course selection to be completed through the online application form)
- Pay the application fee of KRW 100,000 (non-refundable)
- Send the required documents to isc@korea.ac.kr
- Receive the 'Letter of Acceptance' via email
- Pay the tuition and all remaining fees
